13 Young People in Cohort

Full-time Education

8 (61.5%) were in this category, of whom:

- ⇒ 6 (75.0%) were male and 2 (25.0%) were female;
- ⇒ 1 (12.5%) progressed to Level 3 or equivalent courses;
- ⇒ 0 (0.0%) progressed to Level 2 courses (including GCSE);
- ⇒ 7 (87.5%) progressed to courses at Level 1 or below.

Full-time Training - Non-employed

- ⇒ 3 (0.0%) moved into full-time training (including foundation level);

Full-time Employment

- ⇒ 0 (0.0%) moved into full-time employment of which:
- ⇒ 0 (0.0%) were in apprenticeships;
- ⇒ 0 (0.0%) went into jobs with training to NVQ 2 or other locally-recognised
- ⇒ 0 (0.0%) moved into jobs without recognised training

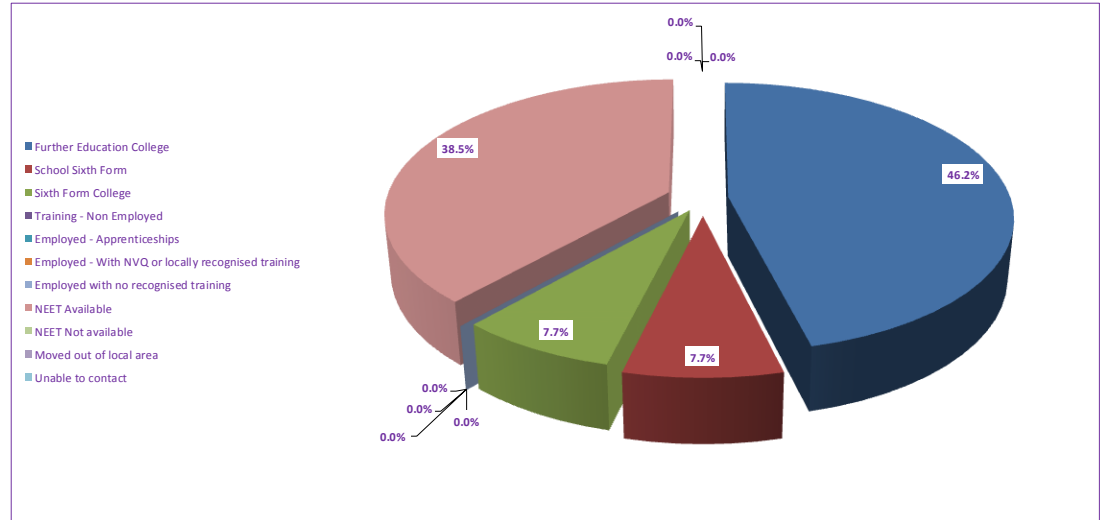
Not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET)
